
### LYMAN TOWN

Welcome to the Executive City Profile for Lyman town. In this document you will find Demographic, Economic, and Housing data from the U.S. Census Bureau. This document uses data from the 2010 U.S. Census, the 2010 Five-Year American Community Survey (ACS), and the most recent 2019 Five-Year ACS to explore local trends in the population, economy, and housing market of Lyman town.

#### **DEMOGRAPHICS**

#### **Population**

Census population estimates from 2000 to 2020 are displayed below and indicate that the population of Lyman town decreased by -1.5 percent from 2,115 persons in 2010 to 2,083 persons in 2020.




#### Population By Race And Ethnicity

In Lyman town, according to the 2010 Five-Year ACS, the White racial population represented the largest share of the total population, accounting for 97.3 percent of the total population, or 2,057 people. By 2019, the White population had decreased by 3.2 percentage points and accounted for 94.1 percent of the total population. In Lyman town, according to the 2019 Five-Year ACS, the largest cohort of population by race was still the White population, accounting for 94.1 percent of the total population in 2019, or 2,151 persons. The fastest growing racial population in Lyman town was the Two or More Races population, which increased by 4.4 percent from 1.0 percent of the total population in 2010 to 5.4 percent in 2019.


# **Hispanic Population**


## **Population By Age**

In Lyman town, according to the 2010 Census, the 5 to 19 age cohort represented the largest share of the total population, accounting for 26.3 percent of the total population, or 556 people. By 2019, the 5 to 19 population had increased by 2.1 percentage points and accounted for 28.4 percent of the total population. In Lyman town, according to the 2019 Five-Year ACS, the largest cohort of population by age was still the 5 to 19 population, accounting for 28.4 percent of the total population in 2019, or 649 persons. The fastest growing age cohort in Lyman town was the 65 and over population, which increased by 5.7 percent from 8.5 percent of the total population in 2010 to 14.2 percent in 2019.


## **Elderly Population By Age**

The elderly population is further explored below. In 2019 those aged 65 to 66 accounted for 25.8 percent of the elderly population, while those aged 67 to 69 accounted for an additional 18.8 percent. The oldest cohort in Lyman town, those aged 85 and older, accounted for 7.7 percent of the elderly population in 2019.


# Disability By Age

The disability rate for females was 16.6 percent in 2019, compared to 16.7 percent for males. The disability rate tends to grow precipitously higher with age, with 69.5 percent of those over 75 experiencing a disability in 2019. Overall, the disability rate in Lyman town was 16.6 in 2019.






### Poverty By Age

In 2019, an estimated 10 percent of the population in Lyman town, or 225 people, were living in poverty, compared to 7.3 percent living in poverty in 2000. In 2019, some 13.4 percent of those in poverty were under age 6 and 0 percent were 65 or older. This compares to an overall statewide poverty rate of 9.9 percent and a nationwide poverty rate of 12.3 percent.




### **Educational Attainment**

In 2019, 87.6 percent of households had a high school education or greater, including 30.9 percent with a high school diploma or equivalent, 32.2 percent with some college, 19.4 percent with a Bachelor Degree, and 5.1 percent with a graduate or professional degree. In comparison, in 2010, 13.1 percent of households in Lyman town had less than a high school education, while 40.7 percent had a high school diploma or equivalent and 8.9 percent had a Bachelors Degree.


### **ECONOMICS**

### **Census Unemployment Estimates**

In 2019, 1,021 people were in the labor force, including 987 employed and 34 unemployed people. The unemployment rate for Lyman town was estimated at 3.3 percent in 2019.



In 2019 the largest industry by employment was the Mining industry in Lyman town, which employed 165 people and paid a median salary of 104,196 dollars. 


### **HOUSING**

### **Housing Units By Type**

In 2010, there were 711 housing units, compared with 874 in 2019. Single-family units accounted for 66 percent of units in 2019, compared to 67.1 percent in 2010. Apartment units accounted for 0.7 percent in 2019, compared to 4.2 percent in 2010.



# **Housing Units By Tenure**

In 2019, there were 874 housing units in Lyman town, of which 799 were occupied and 75 were vacant. Of the vacant housing units, 88.9 percent were owner-occupied, and 11.1 percent were renter-occupied.



### Households By Income

In Lyman town, according to the 2010 Five-Year ACS, the largest cohort of households by income were those making \$75,000 to \$99,999, accounting for 24.9 percent of all households in 2010, or 159 households. In comparison, the smallest cohort of households by income in Lyman town in 2010 were those making \$15,000 to \$19,999, representing 0.0 percent of all households. Between 2010 and the 2019 Five-Year ACS, the share of households making \$75,000 to \$99,999 in Lyman town decreased by 10.3 percentage points and accounted for 14.6 percent of all households in 2019. According to the 2019 Five-Year ACS, the largest cohort of households by income in Lyman town was the \$100,000 or More cohort, accounting for 40.3 percent of the total households in 2019, or 322 households. The fastest growing cohort of households by income between 2010 and 2019 was those making \$100,000 or More, which increased by 22.9 percent from 17.4 percent of all households in 2010 to 40.3 percent in 2019.


## Households By Household Size



#### Households By Year Home Built

In Lyman town, according to the 2010 Five-Year ACS, the largest cohort of households by year built were those built in 1970 to 1979, accounting for 43.4 percent of all households in 2010, or 277 households. In comparison, the smallest cohort of households by year built in Lyman town in 2010 were those built in 1950 to 1959, representing 0.5 percent of all households. Between 2010 and the 2019 Five-Year ACS, the share of households built in 1970 to 1979 in Lyman town decreased by 13.9 percentage points and accounted for 29.5 percent of all households in 2019. According to the 2019 Five-Year ACS, the largest cohort of households by year built in Lyman town was the 1980 to 1989 cohort, accounting for 30.2 percent of the total households in 2019, or 241 households. The fastest growing cohort of households by year built between 2010 and 2019 was those built in 1980 to 1989, which increased by 10.8 percent from 19.4 percent of all households in 2010 to 30.2 percent in 2019.



### Census Vacancy Rate

In 2019 the Owner-Occupied For Sale vacancy rate was 2.6% percent, while the Rental Unit vacancy rate was 12.7% percent in Lyman town.





#### Cost Burden - Total

In Lyman town, according to the 2010 Five-Year ACS, the largest cohort of households by presence of cost burden were those experiencing No Cost Burden, accounting for 84.0 percent of all households in 2010, or 536 households. In comparison, the smallest cohort of households by presence of cost burden in Lyman town in 2010 were those experiencing Severe Cost Burden, representing 2.0 percent of all households. Between 2010 and the 2019 Five-Year ACS, the share of households experiencing No Cost Burden in Lyman town decreased by 1.9 percentage points and accounted for 82.1 percent of all households in 2019. According to the 2019 Five-Year ACS, the largest cohort of households by presence of cost burden in Lyman town was still the No Cost Burden cohort, accounting for 82.1 percent of the total households in 2019, or 656 households. The fastest growing cohort of households by presence of cost burden between 2010 and 2019 was those experiencing Severe Cost Burden, which increased by 3.0 percent from 6.0 percent of all households in 2010 to 9.0 percent in 2019.
