

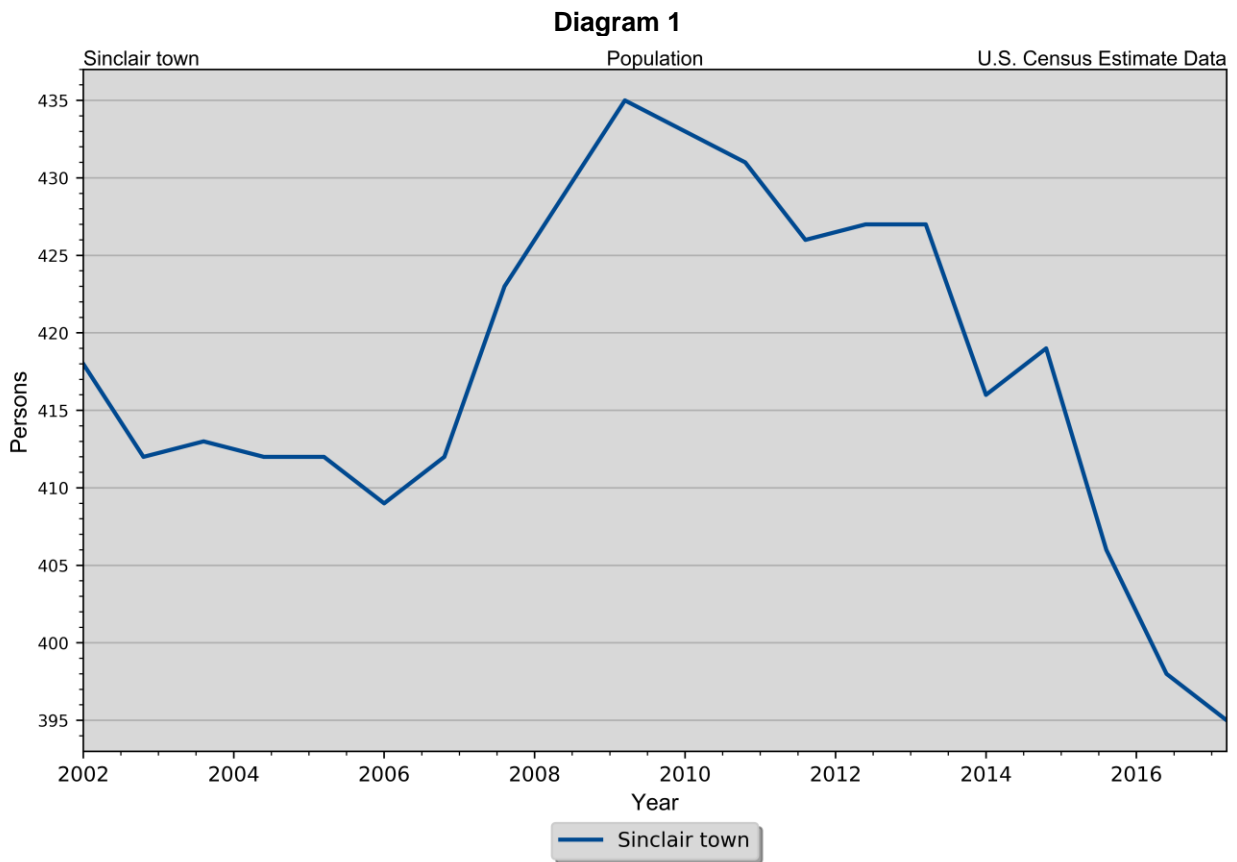
SINCLAIR TOWN

Welcome to the Executive City Profile for Sinclair town. In this document you will find Demographic, Economic, and Housing data from the U.S. Census Bureau. This document uses data from the 2010 U.S. Census, the 2010 Five-Year American Community Survey (ACS), and the most recent 2019 Five-Year ACS to explore local trends in the population, economy, and housing market of Sinclair town.

DEMOGRAPHICS

Population

Census population estimates from 2000 to 2020 are displayed below and indicate that the population of Sinclair town decreased by -10.2 percent from 433 persons in 2010 to 389 persons in 2020.



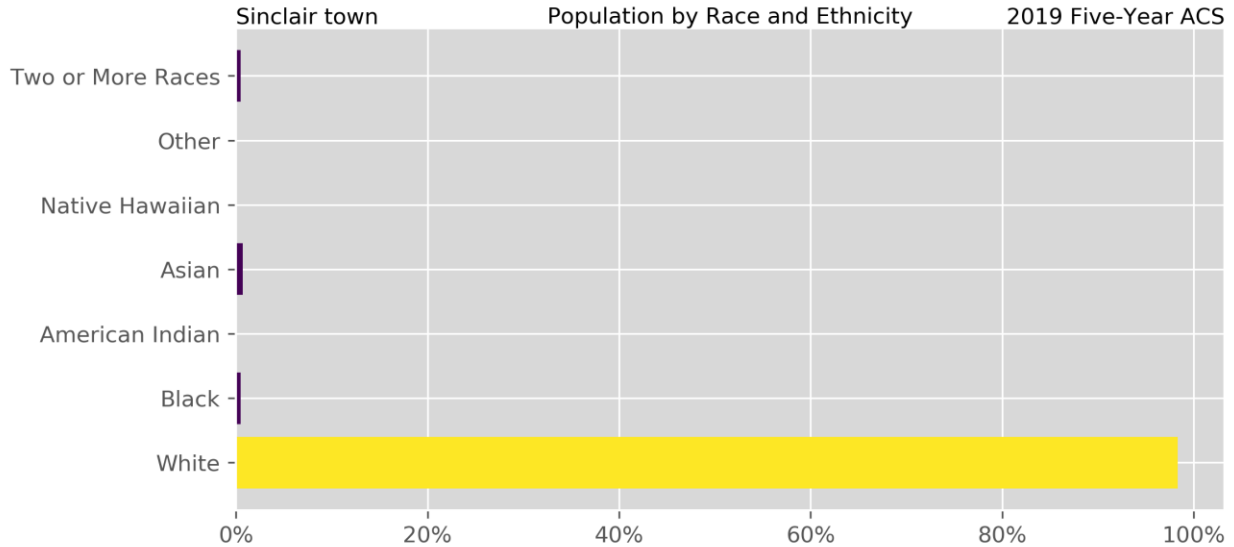
Population By Race And Ethnicity

In Sinclair town, according to the 2010 Five-Year ACS, the White racial population represented the largest share of the total population, accounting for 94.2 percent of the total population, or 408 people. By 2019, the White population had increased by 4.1 percentage points and accounted for 98.3 percent of the total population. In Sinclair town, according to the 2019 Five-Year ACS, the largest cohort of population by race was still the White population, accounting for 98.3 percent of the total population in 2019, or 411 persons. The fastest growing racial population in Sinclair town was the White population, which increased by 4.1 percent from 94.2 percent of the total population in 2010 to 98.3 percent in 2019.

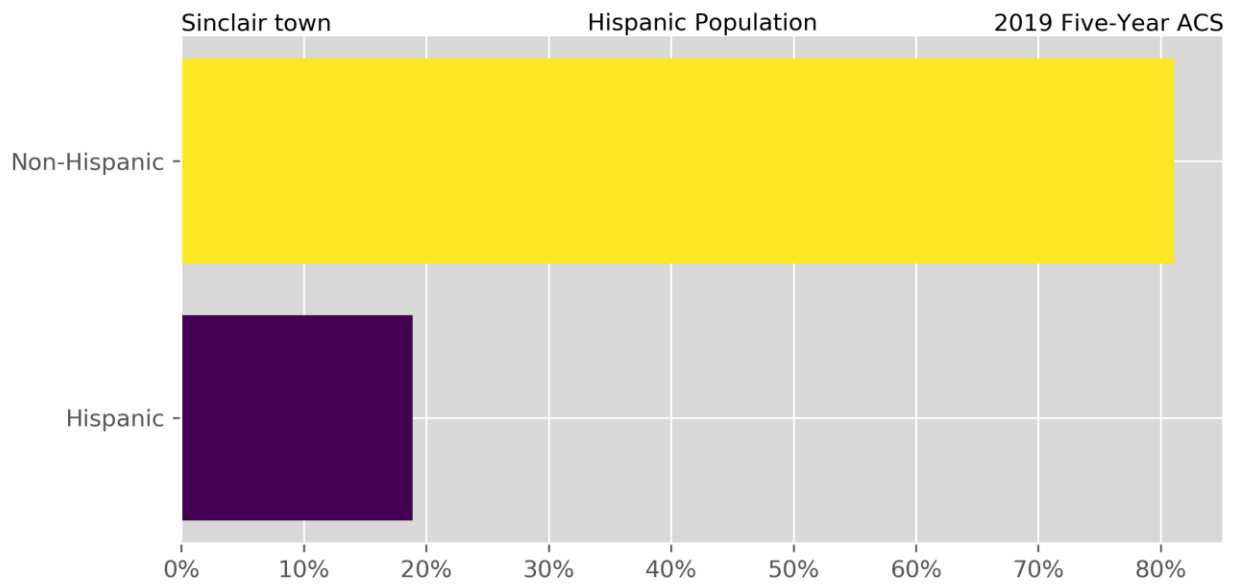
Hispanic Population

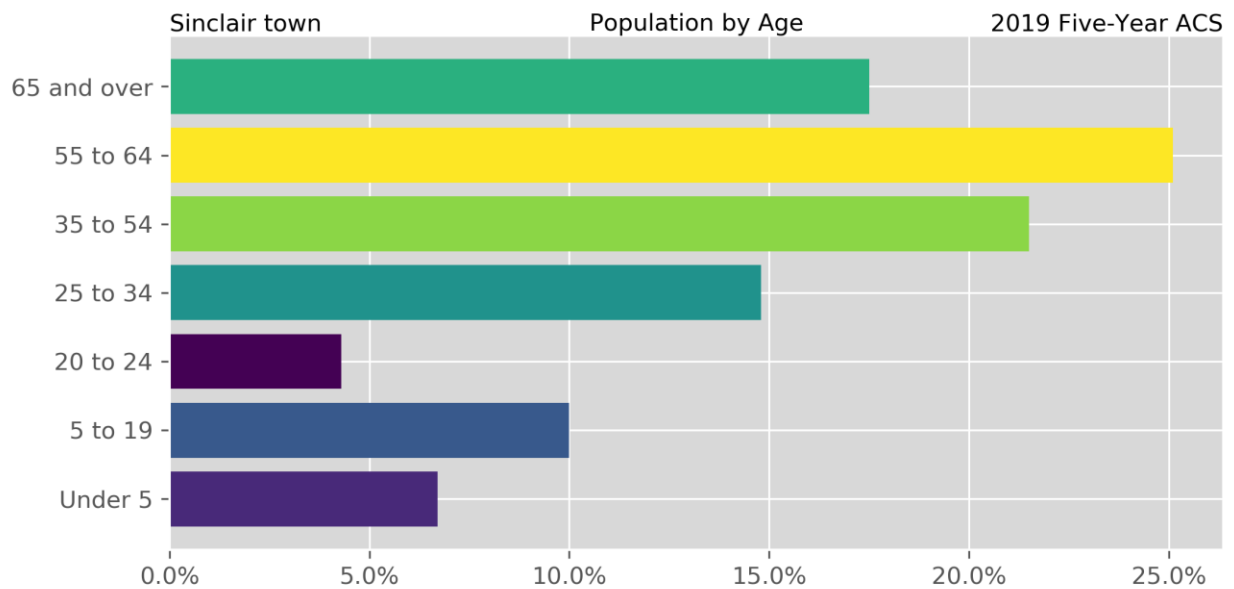
Population By Age

In Sinclair town, according to the 2010 Census, the 35 to 54 age cohort represented the largest share of the total population, accounting for 30.5 percent of the total population, or 132 people. By 2019, the 35 to 54 population had decreased by 9.0 percentage points and accounted for 21.5 percent of the total population. In Sinclair town, according to the 2019 Five-Year ACS, the largest cohort of population by age was the 55 to 64 population, accounting for 25.1 percent of the total population in 2019, or 105 persons. The fastest growing age cohort in Sinclair town was the 55 to 64 population, which increased by 11.0 percent from 14.1 percent of the total population in 2010 to 25.1 percent in 2019.

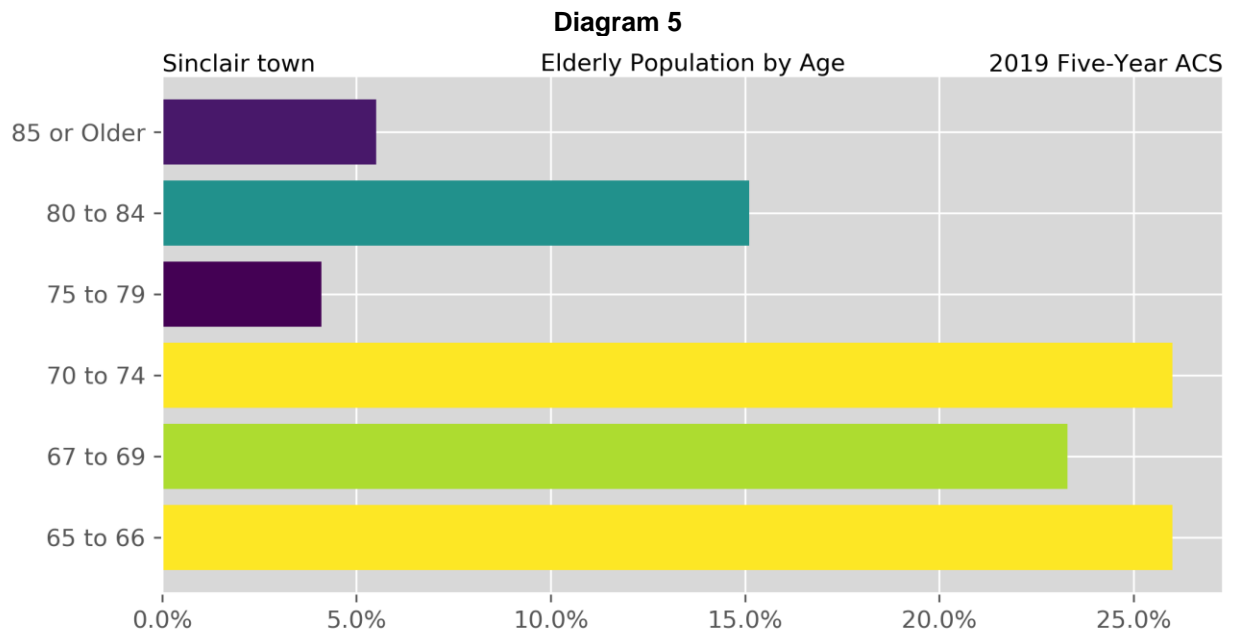

Elderly Population By Age

The elderly population is further explored below. In 2019 those aged 65 to 66 accounted for 26 percent of the elderly population, while those aged 67 to 69 accounted for an additional 23.3 percent. The oldest cohort in Sinclair town, those aged 85 and older, accounted for 5.5 percent of the elderly population in 2019.

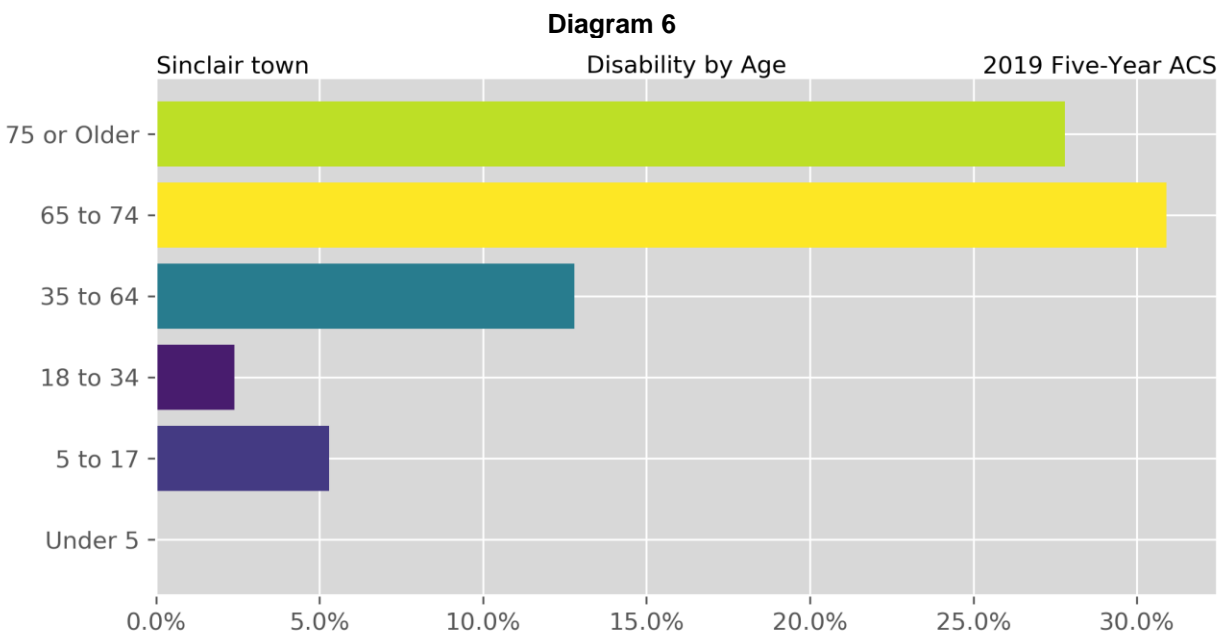

Disability By Age

The disability rate for females was 9.4 percent in 2019, compared to 15.1 percent for males. The disability rate tends to grow precipitously higher with age, with 27.8 percent of those over 75 experiencing a disability in 2019. Overall, the disability rate in Sinclair town was 12.2 in 2019.

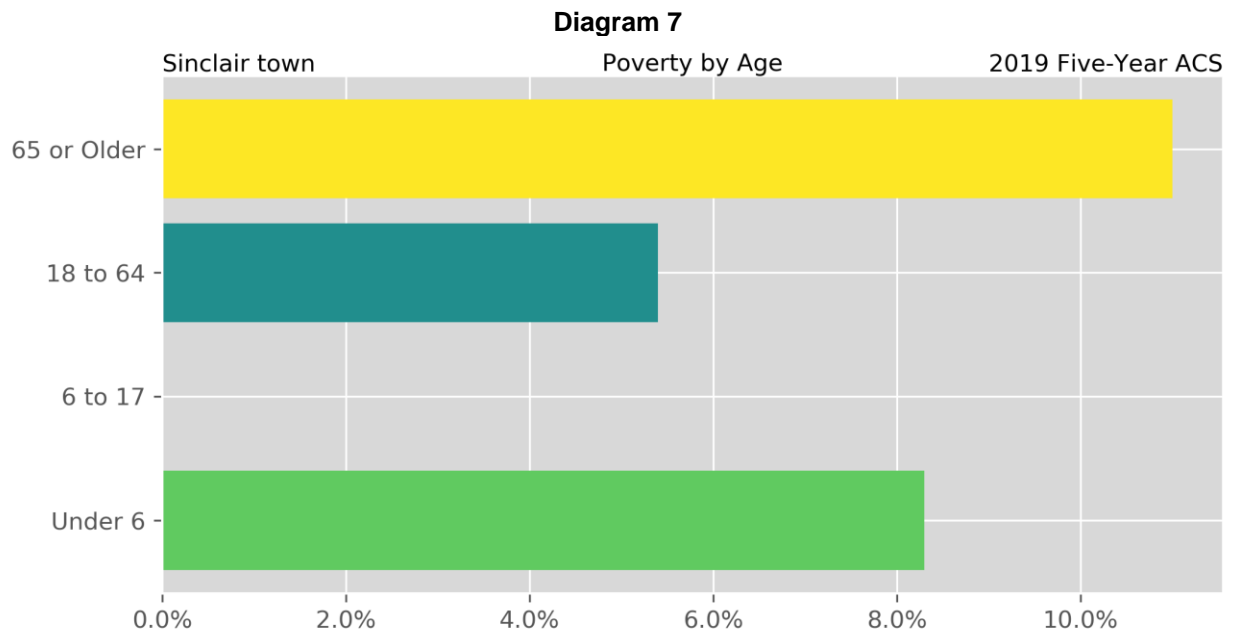

Poverty By Age

In 2019, an estimated 6.3 percent of the population in Sinclair town, or 26 people, were living in poverty, compared to 4.7 percent living in poverty in 2000. In 2019, some 8.3 percent of those in poverty were under age 6 and 11 percent were 65 or older. This compares to an overall statewide poverty rate of 9.9 percent and a nationwide poverty rate of 12.3 percent.

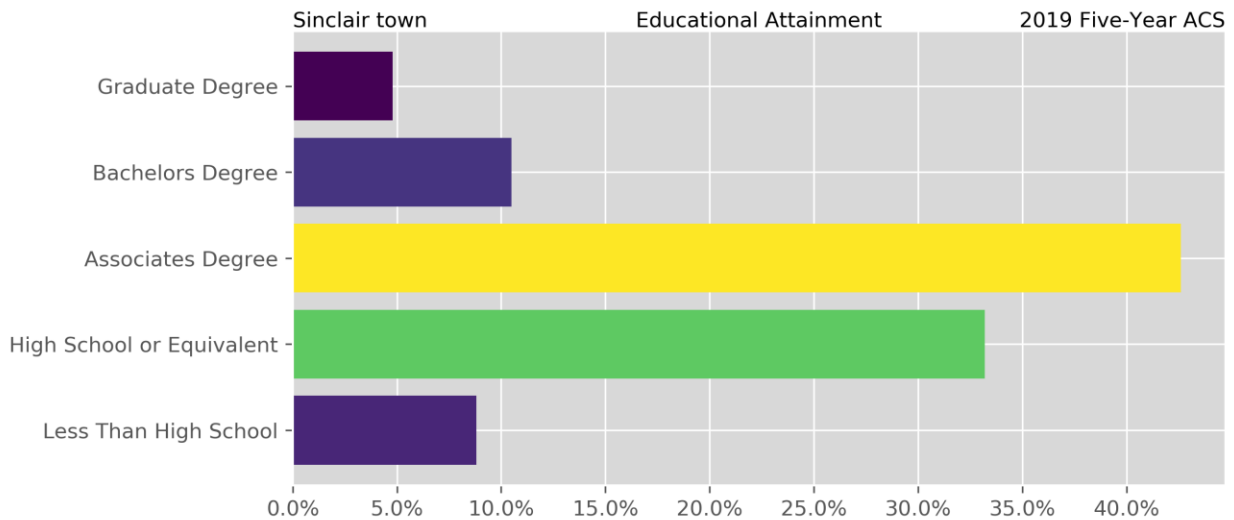
Educational Attainment

In 2019, 91.2 percent of households had a high school education or greater, including 33.2 percent with a high school diploma or equivalent, 42.6 percent with some college, 10.5 percent with a Bachelor Degree, and 4.8 percent with a graduate or professional degree. In comparison, in 2010, 4.4 percent of households in Sinclair town had less than a high school education, while 33.3 percent had a high school diploma or equivalent and 11.7 percent had a Bachelors Degree.

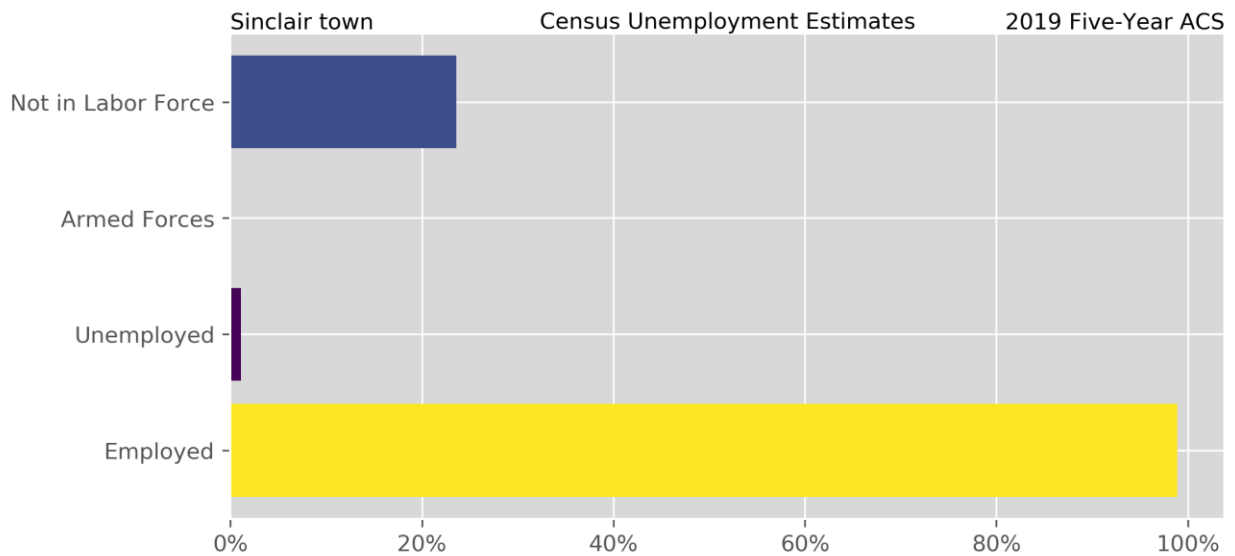
Census Unemployment Estimates

In 2019, 269 people were in the labor force, including 266 employed and 3 unemployed people. The unemployment rate for Sinclair town was estimated at 1.1 percent in 2019.

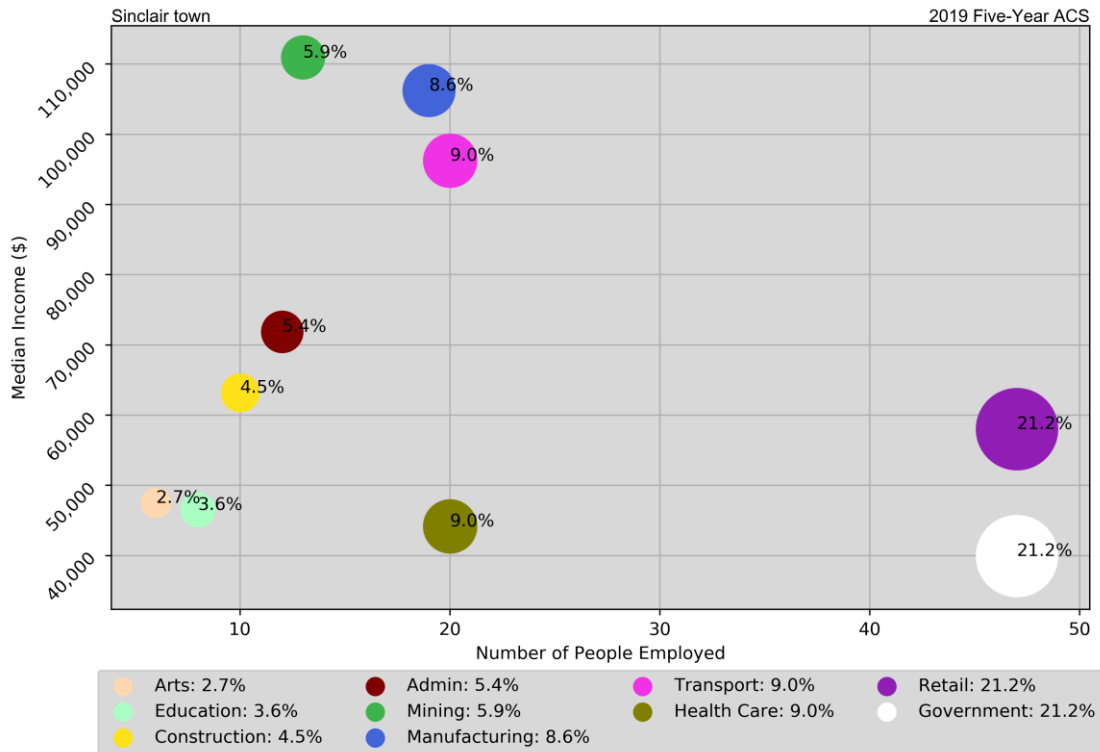
Employment By Industry

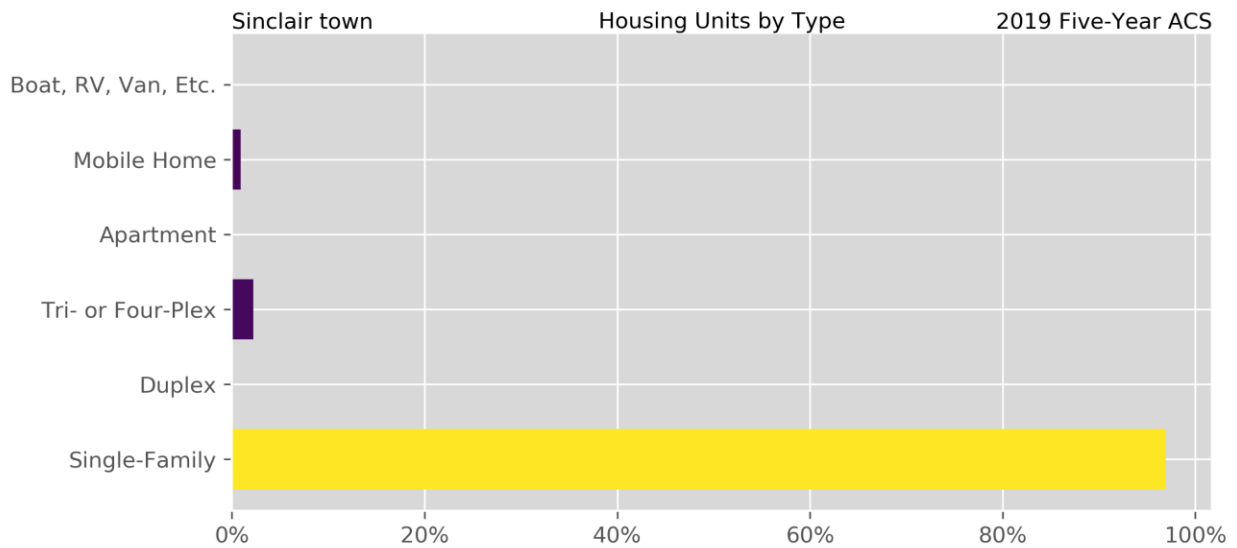

Housing Units By Type

In 2010, there were 248 housing units, compared with 229 in 2019. Single-family units accounted for 96.9 percent of units in 2019, compared to 97.6 percent in 2010. Apartment units accounted for 0 percent in 2019, compared to 0 percent in 2010.

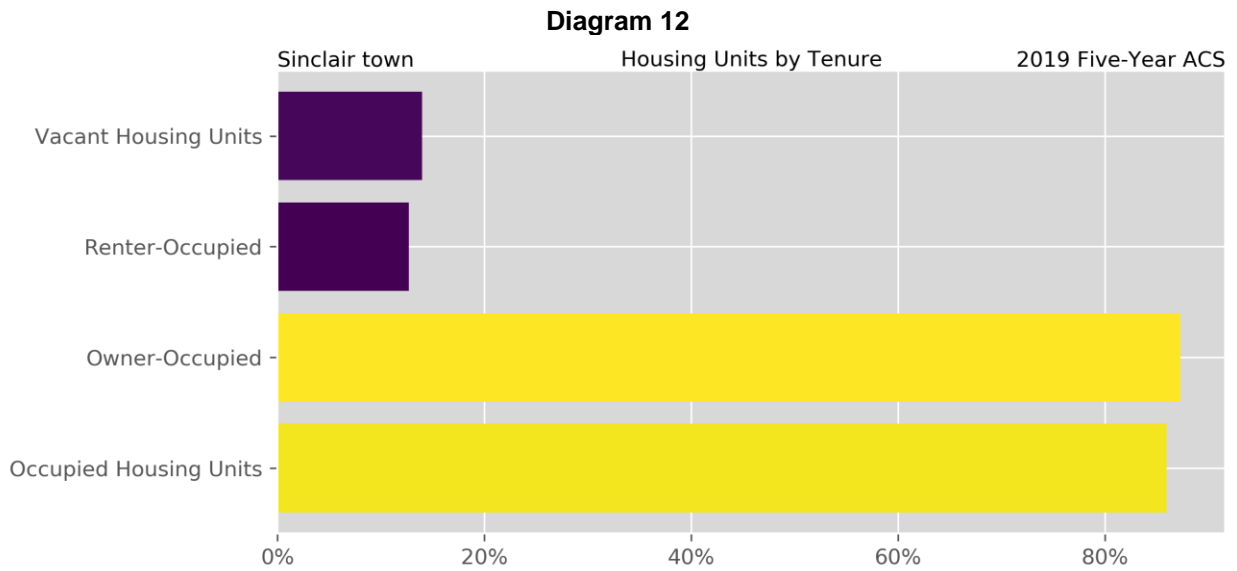

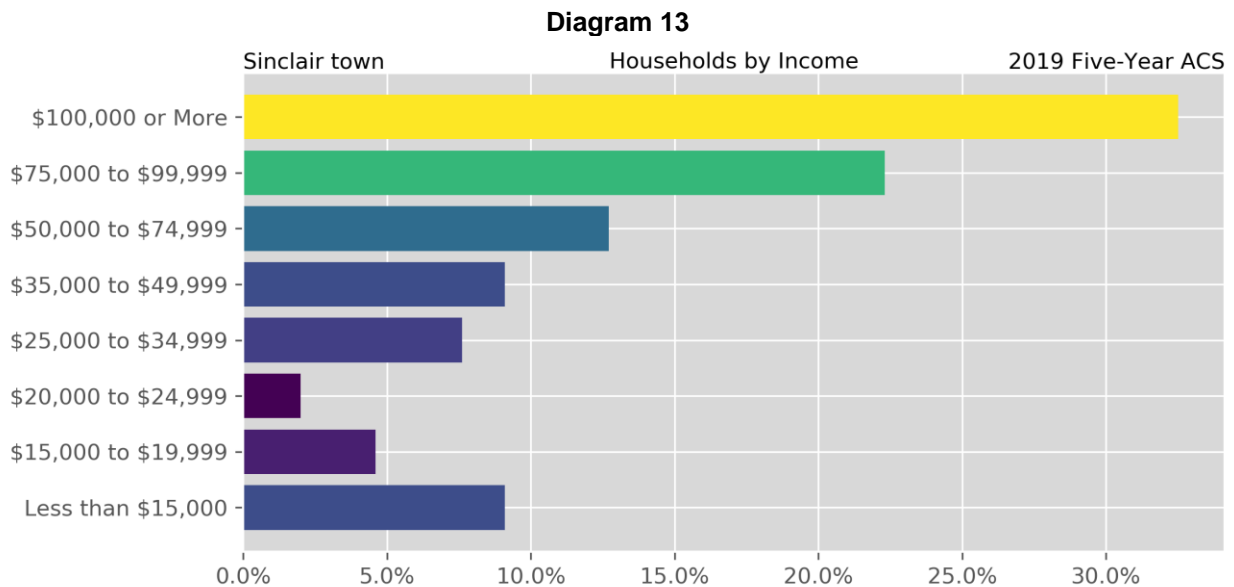

Households By Income

In Sinclair town, according to the 2010 Five-Year ACS, the largest cohort of households by income were those making \$75,000 to \$99,999, accounting for 34.9 percent of all households in 2010, or 74 households. In comparison, the smallest cohort of households by income in Sinclair town in 2010 were those making \$15,000 to \$19,999, representing 0.0 percent of all households. Between 2010 and the 2019 Five-Year ACS, the share of households making \$75,000 to \$99,999 in Sinclair town decreased by 12.6 percentage points and accounted for 22.3 percent of all households in 2019. According to the 2019 Five-Year ACS, the largest cohort of households by income in Sinclair town was the \$100,000 or More cohort, accounting for 32.5 percent of the total households in 2019, or 64 households. The fastest growing cohort of households by income between 2010 and 2019 was those making \$100,000 or More, which increased by 6.6 percent from 25.9 percent of all households in 2010 to 32.5 percent in 2019.

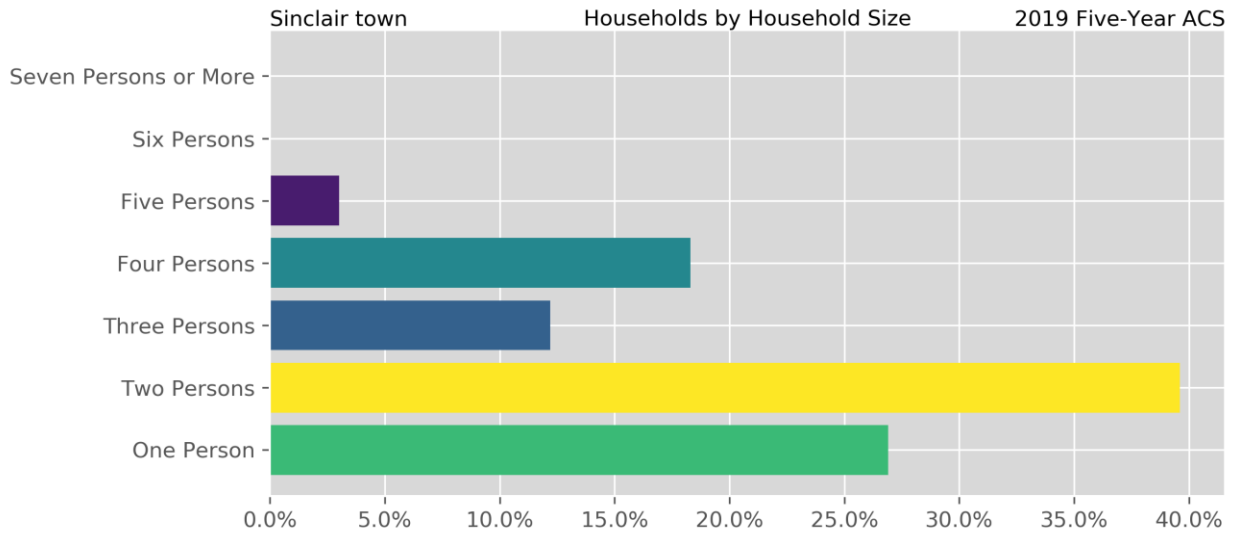
Households By Household Size

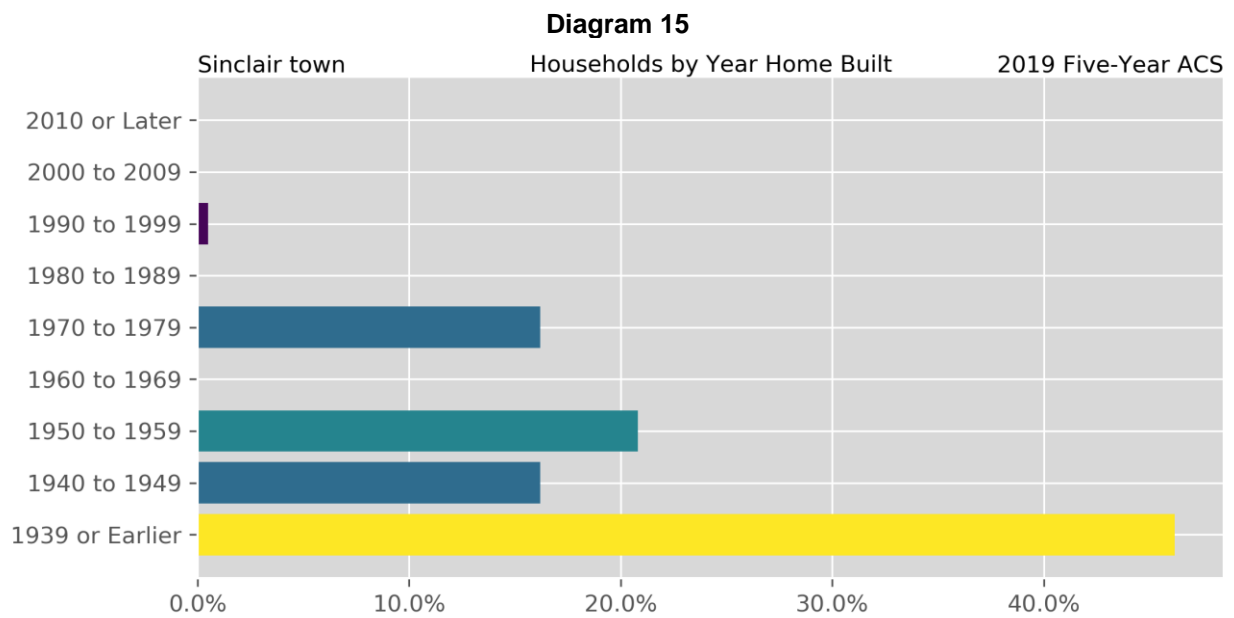

Households By Year Home Built

In Sinclair town, according to the 2010 Five-Year ACS, the largest cohort of households by year built were those built in 1939 or Earlier, accounting for 55.7 percent of all households in 2010, or 118 households. In comparison, the smallest cohort of households by year built in Sinclair town in 2010 were those built in 2000 to 2009, representing 0.0 percent of all households. Between 2010 and the 2019 Five-Year ACS, the share of households built in 1939 or Earlier in Sinclair town decreased by 9.5 percentage points and accounted for 46.2 percent of all households in 2019. According to the 2019 Five-Year ACS, the largest cohort of households by year built in Sinclair town was still the 1939 or Earlier cohort, accounting for 46.2 percent of the total households in 2019, or 91 households. The fastest growing cohort of households by year built between 2010 and 2019 was those built in 1950 to 1959, which increased by 15.1 percent from 5.7 percent of all households in 2010 to 20.8 percent in 2019.



Census Vacancy Rate

In 2019 the Owner-Occupied For Sale vacancy rate was 0.0% percent, while the Rental Unit vacancy rate was 35.9% percent in Sinclair town.

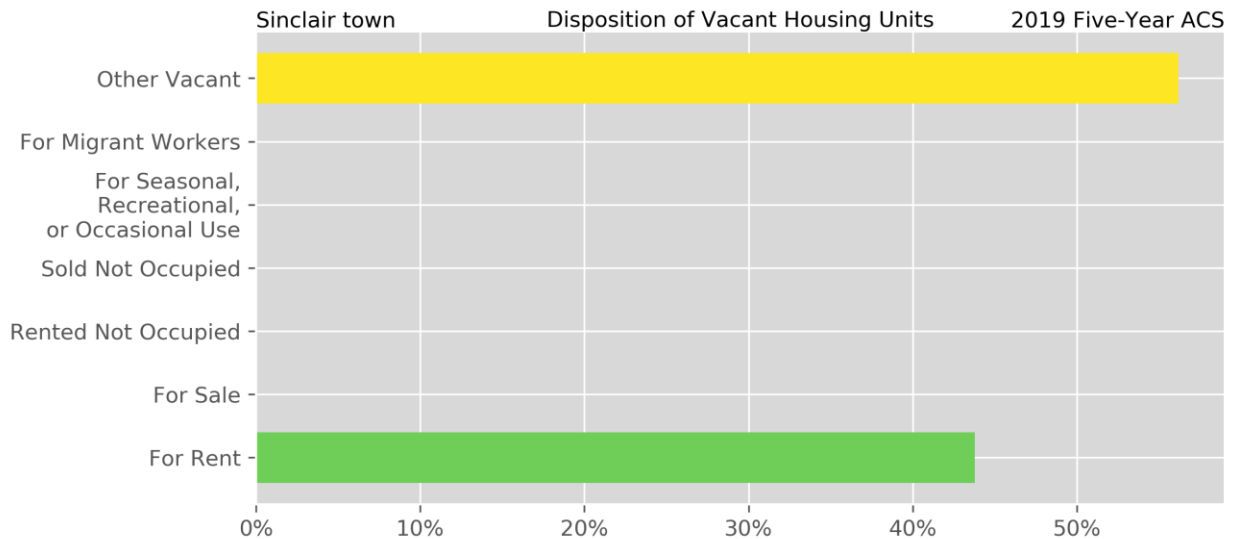
Disposition Of Vacant Housing Units

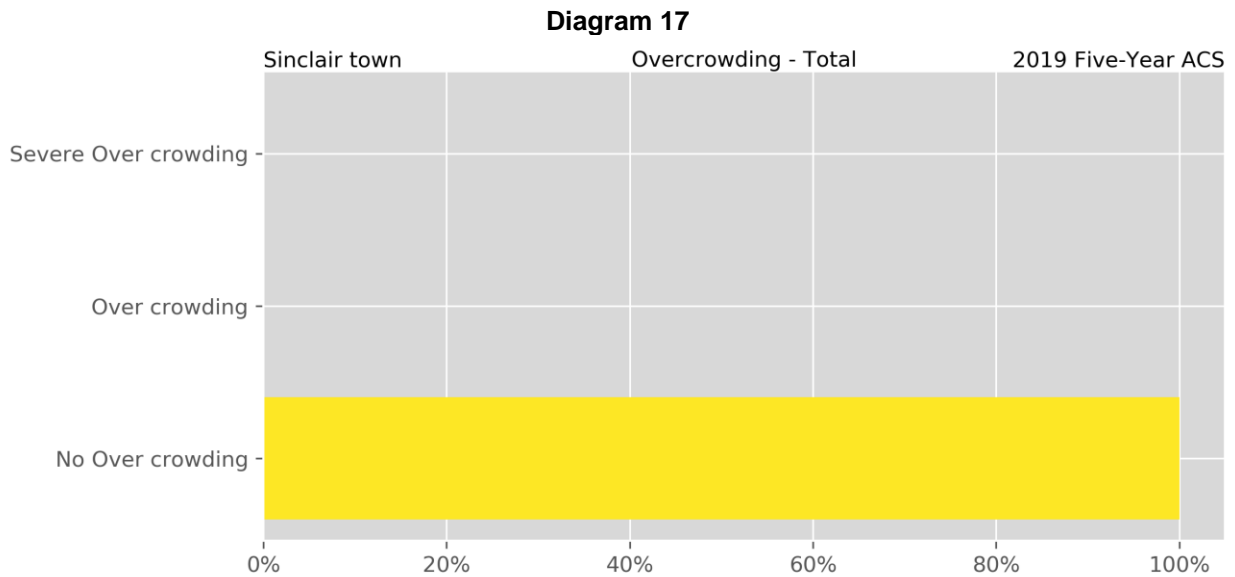

Cost Burden - Total

In Sinclair town, according to the 2010 Five-Year ACS, the largest cohort of households by presence of cost burden were those experiencing No Cost Burden, accounting for 94.8 percent of all households in 2010, or 201 households. In comparison, the smallest cohort of households by presence of cost burden in Sinclair town in 2010 were those experiencing Severe Cost Burden, representing 0.0 percent of all households. Between 2010 and the 2019 Five-Year ACS, the share of households experiencing No Cost Burden in Sinclair town decreased by 8.5 percentage points and accounted for 86.3 percent of all households in 2019. According to the 2019 Five-Year ACS, the largest cohort of households by presence of cost burden in Sinclair town was still the No Cost Burden cohort, accounting for 86.3 percent of the total households in 2019, or 170 households. The fastest growing cohort of households by presence of cost burden between 2010 and 2019 was those experiencing Severe Cost Burden, which increased by 7.1 percent from 0.0 percent of all households in 2010 to 7.1 percent in 2019.
